Show Information and Rules

1. The show is open to in and out-of-state exhibitors that are in 4-H and FFA. Exhibitors must be between the ages of 9 and 21 years of age. We will have a novice showmanship for exhibitors less than 9 years of age.
2. Generators are recommended. Bring your own bedding!
3. The show committee and property owners are not responsible for accidents, theft or injuries during this two-day event.
4. **Entry Fee \$25 per head if postmarked by May 22, 2017. Late entry fee is \$35 per head at show.**
5. Heifers must be born on or after January 1, 2016.
6. Steers and Commercial heifers will be shown by weight. Weighed at the show.
7. Breeding females are shown by their respective breed.
8. Commercial heifer classes are for heifers not registered in any breed.
9. Showmanship: Four divisions – Novice (9 & under), Junior (9-11), Intermediate (12-14), and Senior (15 & above). There can be multiple heats per Division depending upon participation.
10. The B.J. Rice Supreme Showmanship winner will be a competition between the Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Showmanship division winners at the conclusion of the showmanship contest.
11. This is a non-fit show – no adhesives or paints allowed.
12. This is a Junior show – please no unethical practices.
13. Judges placings are final.
14. There is limited barn tie space, available on first come first serve basis. The remaining cattle will have to tie to trailers.
15. Fair grounds open Friday May 26, 2017. No security provided Friday night.
